


WELCOME TO GREATER OSLO



Unforgettable Adventures 📫 Romerike

Norway's most fast-paced experiences are found at Romerike just 20-30 minutes from Oslo. Høy &Lavt Lillestrøm is one of Norway's largest treetop adventure parks with 41 ziplines, climbing facilities and adventures for all ages and levels. Try the latest within VR and AR games or defy gravity with indoor skydiving at Modern Activity Center close to Oslo Airport Gerdermoen. Wrap it up with a walk through historical surroundings down the ravine valley or through Trandum forest. At Fetsund timber booms you can walk on the waterways used by the timbermen. Norway's answer to the Amazon is also located here, the wetland delta Nordre Øyeren with a bustling wildlife and birdlife. Try your skills as a floater at Timberraft.

When the Kids get to Decide Romerike

Walk with alpacas! You can do this at Alpakkavandring in Sørum, Nilsstua, Killingmo Gård and Ulvin Søndre Gård. If you want to feed the animals or join a horseback riding tour visit Rånås Gård or Basnes Trail Rides.

Tertitten museum railway with its steam locomotives takes you on a historic train ride. In Nes you will find the unique fairytale looking Stein school, well worth a visit. Try the newly opened Høyt Under Taket Letohallen in Eidsvoll, a large indoor climbing center with several different climbing activities. Close to Minnesund you will find Mjøssamlingene maritime museum and the Emerald Mines where you can collect your own emeralds.

Daytrip to Vollen 📫 Asker og Bærum

Take the boat from Aker Brygge to Vollen for relaxation and activities like frisbee golf, paddling, and exploring the Oslofjord Museum. **Vollen Marina** offers various activities such as diving, sauna, and SUP rental, along with several charming dining options. Start your day in Slemmestad and walk **the coastal path** to Vollen. Don't forget to buy organic pastries from **Café Plenum**. Experience the **unique geology** of the Oslo belt at Trilobox and discover octopus and snail fossils in the stone fields. **Blue Flag beaches** nearby: Vollen, Sjøstrand, and Hvalstrand.





More Activities and Experiences



Farm Visits and Family Fun 📫 Asker og Bærum

Bergvang farm is open every weekend. Get close to various animals such as rabbits and alpacas. If you want to try dog sledding or horseback riding remember to book in advance. Solli Gård also offers horseback riding tours, with moonlight tours being particularly popular. Rush trampoline park in Bærum offers fligh-high fun for the whole family where you can literally bounce off the walls. Sjøholmen is a unique universe for children with 9 themed rooms featuring scent, light, and colors. Sjøholmen has a café, changing art exhibitions, and hosts creative workshops for both children and adults. From Sandvika, you can take the MS Rigmor ferry for a fjord cruise to beautiful islands in the archipelago, perfect for camping or a relaxing day by the beach. Walk or cycle in the cultural landscape near Dælivann where you can see the petroglyphs of ships from the Bronze Age.

Norway's Most Famous Amusement Park 📭 Follo

Visit Norway's coolest amusement park, **TusenFryd** and try the newest attraction «Storm». Some of Norway's biggest rollercoasters and exciting rides can be found just 25 minutes south of Oslo. Cool down on sunny days in the water park, **BadeFryd** with several pools and thrilling water slides. You get there by bus 505 from Oslo. In the heart of Ås you will find **Vitenparken** science center and café.

Need for Speed N Follo

Experience the Oslo fjord! **Drøbak RIBsafari** organizes boat trips, if you are lucky, you will be able to witness both seals and sea eagles during the tour. **Camp Soon** offers kayak rentals and pleased to help with some instruction if needed. Situated just 30 minutes from Oslo is **Drøbak Golfklubb**, one of Norway's nicest 18-hole courses with a café and driving range. Visit **Drøbak aquarium**, the Oslo fjord's only saltwater aquarium. Say hello to catfish Hugo, ghostly toads and sharks. There is also a childrens touch pool. Spend the night at **Oscarsborg Fortress**, discover the tunnels and get up close to the history. Or take the bus from Oslo to Siggerud and join **Wild Oslo** on a guided tour by kayak or canoe.

















Shopping and Charming Towns

Charming Drøbak 📫 Follo

Drøbak is one of the most visited villages along the Oslo fjord, with a lot of history and narrow streets. Enjoy vibrant city life in the marina, in the **park** and around the square where a market is held every Saturday. A rich selection of small shops, galleries, and cozy eateries. Enjoy seafood and sea views at **Café Sjøstjernen**, or observe the locals from **Kumlegården** and **Galleri Cafè Teskje**. **Tregården Julehus** is Norway's only year-round Christmas house. During the summer season the ferry runs daily from Aker brygge in Oslo to Drøbak.

Norway's Largest Fashion Outlet Norway's Largest Fashion Outlet

Approximately 30 minutes from Oslo you will find **Oslo Fashion Outlet** in Vestby. Over 55 brand stores with 30-70% discount all year round makes for a bargain. Accomodation can be found at **Vestby Park** next door. The coastal gems Son, Hvitsten and Drøbak are just a short drive away. Or take the train to **Ski Storsenter** with 140 shops, bowling, cinema, and a selection of dining options, only 11 minutes from Oslo.

Explore Son and Hvitsten N Follo

Son emerged during the Dutch era in the 17th century and was an important trading post. Today it is a charming village and a popular resort with bustling crowds in summer. **Son harbour** is one of the Oslo fjord's most visited, and you can book a place at Docspot. In Son you will find the local fish shop and a good selection of charming eateries along the harbour promenade. From Son city center it is only a short walk to **Son Spa** hotel. Charming **Hvitsten** near Son was home to the painter Munch. At **Ramme** you can experience an art gallery, guided tours, an organic farm shop and eateries. Stay the night at the cozy boutique hotel, **Ramme fjordhotell**.

The Painter's Village, Drammen Fjord Asker og Bærum Rødtangen and Holmsbu are renowned for their beautiful light, inspiring the elite of artists for many years. Experience Holmsbu Church, known as the artist's church, decorated by 15 of the country's leading painters led by Henrik Sørensen. This historic small town is worth a visit year-round with its small shops and cozy dining options, surrounded by unique nature featuring several nature reserves for great hiking experiences. Stay overnight at the historic Badehotellet or Villa Utsikten in Tofte





More Shopping and Local Trade





Maud's Cradle M Asker og Bærum

Vollen has a long and rich boatbuilding tradition where **Roald Amundsen's** polar ship **Maud** was built. It is now located in Tofte. Learn more about the coast at **the Oslofjord Museum** and wander among fashion and interior design shops. You get the taste of the Mediterranean at **Elea**. Sailors can doc in the **guest harbor**, the adventurous can **dive and rent SUP** in the marina or head up the hill to **Fiori Flowers** for self-picking of flowers and a coffee at the farm shop. Do not miss **Asker Sentrum**, which has a bustling city center, a rich cultural life, good restaurants and lively nightlife.



Art, good food, interior and shopping in historic surroundings. Open every day all year round. Over 400 years of ironworks history and **the country's oldest inn, Værtshuset**, serves delicious meals. More than 40 shops, galleries and eateries idyllically situated along the river Lomma. **The sculpture park** showcases the country's foremost collection of Norwegian sculptors and at **Klart Glass** you can see how glassblowers create their art. A short drive away you will find **Sandvika Storsenter**, one of Norway's largest shopping centres with over 190 shops and eateries.

From Farm Shops to Shopping Centers N Romerike

At Romerike you will find some of the country's best shopping centres and a large number of **farm shops** such as **Loftet Gardsbutikk** and **Amalies Have** with locally produced delicacies, fruits, and vegetables. **Jessheim Storsenter** is located in the heart of Jessheim with 140 shops and pleasant eateries. Martin Whatson has left his mark on the city with its iconic **street art**, the artwork can be found in the underpass at the train station. At Strømmen you will find **Strømmen Storsenter**, one of **Norway's largest shopping centres** with 200 shops. 30 minutes from Kongsvinger is **Magnor Glassverk**. Here they have been producing Norwegian glass design since 1896. Make a bargain at the factory outlet or have a look around the glass hut and see glass blowers in action. On selected days, you can also blow your own glass.

















Art, Culture & History

Architecture and Polar History along the Coastal Path Pollo Let the coastal path along the Oslo fjord lead your way to hidden gems. Visit the home of a polar pioneer. Beautiful Uranienborg at Svartskog, home of Roald Amundsen, remains as he left it when he disappeared in 1928. Enjoy a swim in the sea at Ingierstrand Bad. Notice the unique funkis building from 1934.

Cultural Treasures N Follo

The ferry from Oslo or Drøbak brings you to **Oscarsborg Fortress**. Join a historic excursion including museums and guided tours of the war history. See the cannons that sunk Blücher on April 9th 1940. Extend your visit with dinner and stay the night at **Oscarsborg Hotel and Resort**. In Drøbak you can explore the cozy streets, enjoy a delicious meal in one of the many local cafés or take a trip to Badeparken park. **The Norwegian Cartoonist Gallery** and **Tregaarden's Christmas House** are two of the most popular sights in the town center. Nearby you can find both **Seiersten Skanse**, **the open-air museum Seiersten** and **Follo Museum** with nice outdoor areas and historic buildings.

Edvard Munch and Maritime History No Follo

In Hvitsten you can go hunting for figureheads. Fred Olsen Lines has exhibited 37 figureheads made by famous Norwegian artists, who adorned the company's ships in the period 1938 - 1976. The place was also known as the haunt for famous artists such as Th. Kittelsen, Oda and Christian Krogh, and Edvard Munch. A short walk along the coastal path will lead you to the cultural destination Ramme, which offers guided garden tours, art and performances. Concerts and changing exhibitions are held in the art gallery. Dining and accommodation at the boutique hotel. Make sure to check the opening hours and program in advance.

A Glimpse Into Norway's Past Nomerike

North of Oslo we find most of the museums of the MiA (Museums in Akershus). Enjoy an excursion and experience beautiful fields and meadows, historic buildings such as Stein Skole. Learn about the timber floating history along the river Glomma at Fetsund timber booms. The wetland visitor center Nordre Øyeren - Norway's answer to the Amazon river is located next door. Eidsvoll1814 is a place of importance in Norway's history and liberation. See the original table where our Constitution was signed in 1814.

Hidden Gems North of Oslo North Romerike

Galleri Würth at Gjelleråsen exhibits art from one of Europe's largest private collections, Sammlung Würth. Free entrance and changing exhibitions. Nitja Centre of Contemporary Art can be found in the heart of Lillestrøm and change their exhibitions regularly. In Lillestrøm you can also explore the Riverside Art Park with impressive installations such as "The Hammering Man" and "The Sound of Lillestrøm". Head to Quality Hotel Olavsgaard. The hotel has deployed 25,000 books around the hotel for you to borrow or bring along with you. A visit to the toilets in the basement is a must – you won't be disappointed. The stunning Kepler Star of Vebjørn Sand at the exit to Oslo Airport, is the E6's most famous landmarks and lights up in the darkness. Outdoor art can also be found at Nordbytjernet in Jessheim, at Hurdalsjøen Hotell and Losby Gods – accompanied by a good meal and drinks.

Oslo's Cultural West-Side N Asker og Bærum

The Grini Museum has modern exhibitions in an authentic prison barracks from WW2. Learn about the prisoners' own stories and the story of the war's largest prison camp through film, objects, and modern VR technology. **Henie Onstad Kunstsenter** is a leading art museum within modern and contemporary art, with works from Picasso to Weidemann. Dive into the installation 'Hymn of Life' by **Yayoi Kusama** and stroll in the sculpture park. **Sjøholmen Kulturhus** holds changing exhibitions, creative workshops and serves freshly baked goods. Visit **Fornebu** to look at unique architectural design and take a stroll in the surrounding sculpture park. The old **air traffic control tower** has open artist workshops, galleries, museums, and eateries. Finish with a swim and a good meal at **The Social** at Quality Expo.

Norwegian Sculptors and Writers Norwegian Sculptors and Writers

The sculpture park at **Bærums Verk** has more than 30 works of art by Norway's leading sculptors and the guided walks on weekends are recommended. The old houses and shopping centre has galleries, artists' workshops, glassblowing and more than 40 shops and eateries. **Asker Museum** where **Arne Garborg** lived and wrote has older wooden houses and a beautiful garden with **animal sculptures by Anne Grimdalen**. Daily guided tours of the garden and artists' home of Tilla and Otto Valstad.

















Spa & Wellness

Relax Along the Oslo Fjord 📫 Follo

In the village of Son, **Son Spa** resides with a 2000 sqm spa area with fireplace, pool, jacuzzi, saunas and infrared sauna. At the pier you will find two of Norway's largest floating saunas. The atmosphere of the hotel is unique with fantastic **views of the fjord**. Walking distance to **Son center** with several eateries by the water, cozy shops, galleries, museums, and beautiful beaches. Take the ferry from Aker Brygge to Nesoddtangen. Right next to the ferry terminal you will find **Signalen Sjøbad**, a restaurant which have specialized in sustainable seafood and local produce or take a stroll along the coastal path to **Hellviktangen kunstkafé**.

A World of Wellness 📫 Follo

Only 20 minutes south of Oslo you will find **The Well spa & hotel**, the Nordic region's leading spa and wellness center. The spa is a luxurious oasis featuring a wide range of spa treatments and rituals, 15 saunas, 11 swimming pools and ponds. **Restaurant Mori** serves modern Asian fusion at the top of the hotel. Explore **Gamle Tarnhuset** in Kolbotn and treat yourself with a delicious meal. The restaurant is popular among locals, so it pays off to book a table in advance.

Spa Hotels and Open Air Wellness 🙌 Romerike

Enjoy relaxing days with good food and drinks, spa experiences and walks in the woods. **Rømskog Spa and Resort** is idyllically situated by lake Vortungen. Enjoy activities such as cycling, hiking, canoeing, climbing park and SUP. **Lily Country Club** is a resort housing a spa, restaurant and bar which has quickly become a favorite venue among locals. The spa at **Hurdalsjøen Hotell & Spa** includes a sauna, a heated therapy pool with waterfalls, water massage and a bubble bed. You can also rent a selection of outdoor saunas both by and on the lake. Dinner can be enjoyed at the hotel **restaurant AX. Fjellsjøkampen** (812 m asl) is a popular hiking destination. Enjoy a refreshing swim in lake Hurdalsjøen upon your return!

Unique Accommodation No Romerike

Enjoy the great outdoors. **Rolstad Gård** offers hammock tours and rents out a cabin without water and electricity. Wake up to the sound of birds while the coffee is boiling over open fire. Accommodation with fantastic views of lake Mjøsa is offered at **Konglehytta**, **Villa Heidi** and **Mjøsli Lodge**. Book a stay at one of the unique accommodations at **WonderInn**, **Eidsvoll tree top huts**, **Wergelandshaugen** or **Villa Breen**. Choose between well equipped tiny houses, shepherd's huts, glamping domes, mirrored glass cabins and saunas overlooking the water. View the stars from the glass-igloos of **Hvilepust** or stay overnight by Glomma in the old rest barracks at **Fetsund timber booms**. Live like a duke or duchess at **Losby Gods**. Enjoy afternoon tea or play a game of golf. Spend the evening having a drink while playing shuffleboard, darts, or billiards in Compagniet. Countless hiking opportunities and a lake for swimming

Historic Seaside Resorts Asker og Bærum

When you head out to Asker, it is easy to understand why Christiania's inhabitants spent every summer in the archipelago. **Holmen Fjordhotell** is located by the waterfront with beautiful fjord views. A spa hotel with short distance to the rich cultural life in **Asker** and **Sandvika**. Walk along the coastal path to Hvalstrand or around Semsvann and make a stop at the garden of **Asker Museum**.

The seaside hotel in Holmsbu has been a holiday paradise for more than 140 years. Experience the artists' church, galleries, great hiking opportunities and waterfront eateries such as **Schulestedet** and **Privaten Café**, which regularly hosts concerts. On the southern tip of the Hurum peninsula is **Villa Utsikten**. Explore sandy beaches, sea views and walks along the coastal path to Østnestangen lighthouse. You can arrive in Hurum by public ferry to **Filtvet**, bring a bike and cycle around the peninsula.
